Instruction for Use

- This balaclava must be worn correctly and must cover the intended area of the head and neck during use.
- This balaclava is designed to provide limited protection against heat and flame according to EN ISO 11612:2015.
- It is not intended to provide protection against molten metal splash, chemical splash, electric shock or arc flash hazards.
- For full body protection, this balaclava shall be worn together with other suitable protective garments and PPE selected according to the workplace risk assessment.
- The wearer shall ensure that the balaclava is compatible with other PPE, such as helmets, face shields, respiratory protection, hearing protection, jackets or coveralls.
- Electrostatic dissipative protective clothing shall permanently cover all non-compliant materials during normal use, including bending and movement.
- Workers wearing electrostatic dissipative protective clothing should be properly earthed by wearing suitable electrostatic dissipative footwear or by another appropriate grounding method.
- Electrostatic dissipative protective clothing shall not be opened or removed in flammable or explosive atmospheres or while handling flammable or explosive substances.
- Electrostatic dissipative protective clothing shall not be used in oxygen-enriched atmospheres without prior approval from the responsible safety engineer.
- The electrostatic dissipative performance of the balaclava may be affected by wear, washing, damage or contamination.

Limitations of Use

- This balaclava only provides protection for the areas covered by it.
- Protection may be reduced if the balaclava is damaged, heavily worn, dirty, contaminated, incorrectly worn or not used together with suitable PPE.
- Do not use this balaclava if it is contaminated with grease, oil, flammable liquids or combustible materials.
- In the event of accidental contamination by chemical or flammable liquid, the wearer shall immediately withdraw from the hazard area and carefully remove the balaclava, ensuring that the contaminant does not come into contact with the skin. The balaclava shall then be cleaned or removed from service.
- Dirty clothing may lead to a reduction in protection.

Repair and Replacement Instructions

- Repairs are only allowed in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
- Repairs shall not impair the protective performance of the balaclava.
- Repair only with identical materials and by suitably qualified companies.
- Damaged balaclava shall be repaired or replaced.
- Balaclava with tears, holes, excessive wear, damaged seams or contamination that cannot be removed shall be removed from service.

Washing Instructions

- This balaclava is made from inherently flame-retardant fabric. The flame-retardant properties are not unduly affected by normal washing.
- Balaclavas are certified after twenty five wash cycles.
- Use home washing only. Do not industrial wash.
- Recommended washing temperature: 40°C.
- Rinse well. Do not wring. Do not tumble dry.
- After washing, the balaclava shall be visually inspected for any signs of damage.
- The stated maximum number of cleaning cycles is not the only factor related to the lifetime of the balaclava. The lifetime also depends on use, care, storage, contamination and wear.

Care instructions	Machine wash 40°C; One dot iron - low heat; Do not bleach; Do not dry clean; Do not tumble dry; Do not use soap; Use detergent only.
Storage	Store in dry, clean and dust-free conditions. Do not store under intensive light exposure. Keep away from heat sources, chemicals, oils, grease and sharp objects.
Material	59% Modacrylic / 38% Cotton / 3% Elastane with Antistatic
